General Mobility Aids

These items can help you move safely and independently:

- Canes** – Provide light support and balance.
- Walkers & Rollators** – Offer more walking stability; rollators have seats and brakes.
- Wheelchairs** – For those with difficulty walking; manual or powered options.
- Grab Bars** – Can be installed along hallways or near steps for extra support.

Bathroom Safety Equipment

The bathroom is a high-risk area for falls. These items can improve safety:

- Shower Chairs & Bath Benches** – Allow seated bathing to reduce slips.
- Grab Bars** – Provide support entering/exiting the tub.
- Non-Slip Mats & Adhesive Treads** – Prevent slipping in wet areas.
- Raised Toilet Seats** – Make sitting and standing easier, reducing strain.
- Power Bath Lifts** – Mechanized seats that lower and raise users in the tub.

Transfer Aids

These tools help with safe movement between surfaces:

- Transfer Boards** – Smooth boards that bridge gaps between bed, chair, or wheelchair.
- Hoyer Lifts (Manual or Electric)** – Help caregivers move individuals safely.
- Bed Rails** – Prevent falls from bed and assist with repositioning.
- Lift Recliner** – Motorized chair to help from seated to standing position.
